

# Blessed Pope John Paul II Chaplet

On the Pope John Paul II medal start with:

Eternal Father, in your wise and loving providence  
You raised up Pope John Paul the second as a father and shepherd  
for Your Universal Church here on earth.  
For all the pope's help and work through the years he was with us,  
we are truly grateful. I ask you Father, through the intercession  
of Pope John Paul II, for the help of (here mention your request)  
if it be in accordance with Your will.  
May I be ever mindful of the help and blessings I receive and  
one day may I make it to Heaven to sing Your praises with  
Pope John Paul II, the Blessed Virgin Mary, all the angels  
and all the saints, forever and ever. Amen.

On the nine beads pray three Our Father, three Hail Mary and three Glory Be prayers.

On the Crucifix pray the Apostles Creed:

I believe in God, the Father Almighty, Creator of Heaven and earth;  
and in Jesus Christ, His only Son Our Lord,  
Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried.  
He descended into Hell; the third day He rose again from the dead;  
He ascended into Heaven, and sits at the right hand of God, the Father Almighty;  
from there He shall come to judge the living and the dead.  
I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Amen.

O God, You are our Creator.  
You are good and Your mercy knows no bounds.  
To You arises the praise of every creature.  
O God, You have given us an inner law by which we must live.
